- Pondering death and the afterlife
- Thoughtful
- Reflective of humanity's place in history
- Melancholy
- Celebration of life

Stanzas: At least three

Verses: Minimum of 18

Rhyme Scheme: Couplets (AA, BB, CC, DD, EE, etc).
